Calling WA Choral Composers

A project to encourage and celebrate new choral composition

Tasting the Fruits, phase 2 of the ANCA WA Growing Our Own project

Tasting the Fruits is a choral workshop on the 2nd of May 2021 at which we will rehearse and discuss selected compositions by WA composers. The workshop will be led by prominent Perth Choir VOYCES, directed by Dr Robert Braham, augmented by workshop participants. Composers are invited to submit works for consideration by a panel for rehearsal at the event.

ANCA WA sets out to introduce our West Australian composers to the broader choral community. Works can be for choirs at different levels of their development e.g. Junior School, Senior School, University or Adult Community choirs, or choirs who are working at a semi-professional level.

Composers of all ages and levels of experience are invited to:

- Compose a work for choir *a cappella* with a duration of no more than four minutes.
- Works may be for SATB, SA, SSA, or TBarB or SAB or any suitable combination (Composers may submit works for more than one category).
- Submissions should be copyright-cleared for the use of texts.
- Work should be computer notated. Submissions should be emailed as .pdf attachments to wa@anca.org.au by 15 February 2021.

- Selected scores will be emailed to registered participants in advance of the workshop session.

This event is aimed at choral directors, choral singers, music students and teachers. It sets the precedent for a regular cycle of projects intended to raise consciousness of composing for the medium of choral ensembles of all kinds.
